

Lupe Reyes




This Mexican inspired restaurant greets you with homemade tortillas and Mezcal. promising an authentic taqueria experience.

· Condado Beach

Brings a dose of Miami to Puerto Rico, drawing everyone from celebrities and honeymooning couples to families with small kids.

Plavita del Condado

The quieter, more compact sister of Condado Beach, Playita del Condado is known for the clarity of its waters. What it lacks in size, it makes up for in its beauty - with towering trees lining the back of the beach providing plenty of shade in the morning and early afternoon.

Escambron Beach

· Isla Verde Beach

Near Event HISTORIC SITE

Experience Old San Juan, in Puerto Rico's capital and center of history and culture.

Blends elements of the Old World (cobblestone streets and colonial architecture) with all the amenities of modern urban life (craft cocktails, contemporary dining, amazing shopping, and vibrant nightlife). Immerse yourself in the culture and explore the wealth of art, food, adventure, and beauty that is waiting to be discovered.

Historical Landmarks

The Old World comes alive at fortresses like El Morro and San Cristóbal. These impressive citadels are part of the San Juan National Historic Site and are two of the largest fortifications built by the Spaniards in the Caribbean during the 16th century.

Other important landmarks include Museo Casa Blanca (the one-time residence of the family of Juan Ponce de León that was built in 1521), the San Juan Cathedral, the Santa María Magdalena de Pazzis Cemetery, and the Museo de las Américas. Catedral de San Juan that is the second oldest church in America and the world's first archdiocese founded an beside Parque de las Palomas that impress with the gorgeous views of the bay.

Near Event SHOPPING

You'll find a wide variety of shopping in Puerto Rico. Whether you're searching for souvenirs, locally-made hand-crafted items, or major brands, you can peruse and purchase from malls, designer boutiques, and locally-owned shops.



Condado's laid-back luxury

Means access to everything from upscale shops to exclusive entertainment. Stroll down Ashford Avenue - the Puerto Rican "Fifth Avenue" where exquisite eateries and opulent shopping await. World-renowned brands such as Cartier, Louis Vuitton, Gucci, Salvatore Ferragamo, and more have a presence on the Avenue, as well as boutiques by local designers like Nono Maldonado, Lisa Thon, Harry Robles, and Ecliptica.



Plaza Las Américas

Plaza Las Américas in Hato Rey (a district in San Juan) is the largest shopping center in the Caribbean and offers everything from food courts to movie theaters and more than 300

different stores! Whether you're in the market for a luxury item or just want to take an indoor stroll, this will be your one-stop place to shop.



Mall of San Juan

For a more luxurious shopping experience that includes name brands, head to The Mall of San Juan. Piñones

Roadside food stand-hopping is what Puerto Ricans call chinchorreo, something you will have plenty of opportunity to do if you travel the rural roads of Piñones, the region where Carolina is located. The coastal line one of Puerto Rico's most picturesque drives — runs from Carolina to Loíza, and you can stop at many beaches and food kiosks along the way.

Yunque / Luquillo Beach and Kiosks
